There is a Federal Police force comprising of almost 50,000 personnel, that is a cop for ten citizens, that tantamount to the highest police: citizen ratio in the world. Also in the content and context of Pakistan the Islamabad Police is both the clite and the model police force. Yet to the chagrin and despondence of the citizens, the crime graph has multiplied by 200% over the past three years.
