

The accusations against Paki stan's Acting High Commis sioner in India MrJalil Abbas Jilani is part of the conspiracy hatched by the BJP government since December 13, 2001 that Islamabad is engaged in stoking Kashmiri's freedom struggle and abetting the thirteen year old militancy against Indian occupation of Jammu and Kashmir.

It is part of the bigger Indian conspiracy to exploit the 9-11 terrorist attacks of the Twin Towers in New York to corner Pakistan its declared enemy, and alienate it from the world community. As a matter of fact they have never recovered from the after effects of the terrorist attacks on the Parliament House in December 2001.

Now with the expulsions of even the Deputy High Commissioners, their mutual diplotheir matic presence in the two capitals virtually has fallen to an irreducible mini-mum. It was done to find an excuse for yet another crackdown on the APHC leaders, most of whom are already in sub-human Indian jails. The GOP has called upon the Indian government to end its systematic campaign of disinformation against Pakistan, and bring to an end the suppression of the Kashmiri people.

After that Pakistan ordered Mr Sudhir Vyas the Indian deputy High Commissioner to Leave Islamabad. While the Indian decision without any due enquiry smacks of depraved diplomacy and destructive politics, Pakistan was left with no choice but to order Sudhir Vyas out, Pakistan's was an unavoidable tit for tat move. These are energy and strong words, but clearly India had hit the gutter in diplomatic etiquette by including the name of Mr Jilani in a fabricated FIR by the Delhi police. The Indian government would have ordered an enquiry if there was any truth to this blatant allegation concerning the payment of three hundred thousand rupees to two members of the All parties Hurriyet Conference.

In the absence of any proof, the motive of the inimical action clearly is to tarnish Pakistan imige and malign the APHC, which today is the mouthpiece of the people of Occupied Jammu and Kashmir. The octogenarian, senile and neurotic BJP rulers seem to have lost their mental balance under the influence of Muslim and Pakistan hating Vishwa Prishad, Bajrang Dal, Shiv Sena and Jan Sanghi Hindu bigots.

The political mileage they hope to gain from their hate Pakistan propaganda and political campaign to malign Pakistan and the APHC is bound to boomerang. And when it does, it will be the fury of the exploited Indian masses, which will hit and destroy the BJP and other Hindu extremists who are preaching hate and violence.

On Friday the Indian High Commissioner was summoned to the Foreign Office to receive a strong protest about the Indian action against Mr Jalil Abbas Jilani and other Pakistani diplomats. Indian action was described as ridiculous and baseless.

He was conveyed the concern of the Government of Pakistan on the ongoing vilification campaign, which is part of the BJP strategy to mislead Indian public opinion to whip up anti-Pakistan hysteria for electoral gains. The representatives of the All Parties Hurriyet Conference were falsely framed to discredit the freedom movelost interest in Pakistan as a frontline state af-

ter the defeat of the Taliban in Afghanistan." The response to this provocation must be balanced. Pakistan as a frontline state of the Coalition against terrorism has been acknowledged by President George Bush, Prime Minister Tony Blair, President Jacques Chirac, President Vladimir Putin and by all western heads of states and governments.

UN Secretary General Kofi Annan has been all praise for Pakistan's role. Pakistan's leadership in the war against terrorism is the biggest thorn in India's side. It is for this reason that Indian rulers and media continue their nefarious propaganda to belittle Pakistan's achievements in the war against domestic and international terrorists.

And it is for this very reason that the Indian Prime Minister and his number two make use of every opportunity to lash at Pakistan, at the APHC and at the Kashmiri freedom fighters.
